Even one whose is, G-d forbid, orphaned from his father, declares before beginning the Ma Nishtana (The Four Questions), "Father, I am going to ask you four questions." (HaYom Yom, 16 Nissan)

The Pesach seder revolves around our children because children are free; only through our inner child can we achieve liberation. This was true of the Exodus, and it is true of the Final Redemption.

On Pesach, we eat matzah that is flat, simple, and tasteless. We do this to teach us to be humble and to have a childlike simplicity and a sense of wonder. These qualities strengthen our faith and make us whole; they prepare us for Redemption.
