MOSHIACH'S SEUDA: NOT JUST A SYMBOL, BUT A TASTE

The Baal Shem Tov called the (third) meal of this day the feast of Moshiach...because on this day, the light of Moshiach shines openly. (Likkutei Sichos vol. 7, pg. 272.)

The first days of Pesach celebrate the Exodus from Egypt. The last days of Pesach celebrate the Final Redemption that will occur through Moshiach.

We celebrate with a festive meal to show that Moshiach is not something beyond us. Rather, Moshiach is as real in our eyes as the food in front of us.

Even now, while still in exile, G-d gives us free will, He gives us his Torah, and He even gives us the Torah's secrets, the Torah of Moshiach. We celebrate with a feast to help us make the joy of these gifts tangible.
