## LIVING IN THE MOMENT

*In every generation (and every day), one must conduct himself as if he were leaving Egypt at this very moment.  
(Rambam, Mada, Chametz U'Matza 7:8; Tanya 47)*

Our sages tell us that it is not enough to commemorate liberation; we must live as free men.

It is normal for a person to feel chained to his past, that he must fulfill an unwritten obligation to the world to continue to be who he once was. This, however, is not the case.
